Airport **“Meeting and Assistance”** is \$60 for 1-4 passengers on the same flight. Bus Line 485 is now working 24 hours a day, a bus every hour for 16 NIS per person. It is located at the arrivals hall area at terminal 3. Other arrangements may be possible. Please email or call for more information.
